Recent studies have demonstrated that children and adolescents on the autistic spectrum are overrepresented in clinics addressing gender dysphoria/incongruence. As we know, they have "atypical" neurobiology and sensory processing that can impact their perceptions of their objects, the environment and themselves and thus may formulate their "identifications" quite differently than "neurotypical" children. As a result, many may struggle to establish a sense of a stable self, including gender identity, in an apparently seamless developmental unfolding. As a result, children on the spectrum with their developmental differences may offer us opportunities to learn how gender and other identities may evolve over time.

Objectives: at the end of this presentation, participants will be able to (1) define "identification"; (2) describe how the process of identification may differ in children and adolescents on the spectrum; and (3) explain how atypical sensory experiences and processing might lead to experiences of gender dysphoria/incongruence.

Susan Donner, M.D. is a child, adolescent and adult psychiatrist and psychoanalyst in private practice in Woodland Hills, CA. She graduated from the New Center for Psychoanalysis in the child and adult analytic programs and is now a Training Analyst; Child, Adolescent and Adult Supervising Analyst; Chair of the Child and Adolescent Psychoanalytic Training Program and Director of the NCP's 0-21 low fee Psychoanalytic Clinic. She is an Associate Clinical Professor in Psychiatry at UCLA Geffen School of Medicine. She is also the recipient of the 2019 Rieger Psychodynamic Psychotherapy Prize given by the American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry for the paper, now published in the Psychoanalytic Study of the Child (2021) "Making Meaning through Play: Psychoanalytic Intervention in a Pre-School Child with Global Developmental Delay."
